Although our campsite wasn't particularly scenic, we did have some cute visitors.




And it was a relief to realize that the mountains were obscured by clouds, not smoke.



As I looked through my photos from Jasper, I was confused by how few there were. And then I remembered: We made a video in Jasper! And caught up on blogs!




... and then to Edith Lake. There we went for a lovely walk. (Some might call it a hike, but that would probably be an exaggeration.)

More walking...






... More wonder.

We moved on to Pyramid Lake, which wasn't quite as spectacular, but we found a nice spot to have some lunch.






Then it was back to the serious work of video production...
