
Kate & Jim's Travels with Charles

We left Jasper and aimed Charles toward Edmonton, where our friends John & Glen had invited us to visit.


Though we could've made the trip in one day, we decided, once again, to take the scenic route.






It was also surrounded by spectacular mountains.

Every time we rounded a bend there was another incredible photo op.





